

Amelia Crowfoot Clark Memorial Scholarship Award

Presented by Old Sun Community College and the Blackfoot 5

Description

Financial award of \$750 and a plaque. Presented and awarded December 17, 2021. This will be an annual award presented by the Blackfoot 5.

Criteria

1. UCalgary student of Siksika decent/Part of the Blackfoot Confederacy (Siksika, Kainai, Piikuni, Amskaa Piikuni), student completing graduate degree
2. Shows compassion, kindness, and an interest in maintaining Blackfoot culture and traditions within their graduate degree
3. Role model: has led their work experience with a commitment to the Blackfoot people.
4. Has overcome many obstacles to obtain a graduate degree. This will be expressed in a 1000-1500 word document outlining your journey to obtaining the degree

Application Process

- 1000-1500 word document outlining the above criteria.
- Include the ancestral bloodline to the Blackfoot Confederacy if not registered from a Blackfoot band
- 2 letters of reference from colleagues not related to applicant

Deadline: Dec 1, 2021 submit to OSCC in an envelope marked "Amelia Crowfoot Clark Award" (will be date stamped). No late submissions accepted.
